2.BATTERY

- By owning, charging or using the Li-battery, you assume all risks associated with the use of lithium hatteries
- Always keep out of reach of children.
- Never leave the battery unattended while charging.
- Never leave the battery charged for more than 1 hour.
- Use only the USB charger provided in the pack. Never use a non-adaptable charger.
- Before charging the battery, check that it is not damaged. Check that the battery has not swollen or that the battery compartment is not punctured. If you notice any of these situations: DO NOT CHARGE THE BATTERY!
- A used battery must be removed from the unit and replaced.
- If you notice that the battery starts to swell during charging, disconnect the battery immediately
 and do not use it again. Continued use of an inflated or deteriorated battery may cause an explosion.
 Make sure that the output voltage of the charger matches the battery voltage. Do not charge at a
 higher current than recommended. Use only the charger provided in the pack.
- Disconnect the battery from the charger if it becomes too hot (Never exceed 49 ° C / 120 ° F) or swells.
- If the battery becomes hot, disconnect the charger immediately.
- Charge only on non-flammable surfaces. Never charge inside a vehicle!
 Do not expose the battery to any source of heat or high temperature.
- Never put the battery in contact with water or immerse it in any other liquid.

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- Improper use of the battery may cause fire, explosion or other hazards.
- In case of fire caused by the battery, do not use water to extinguish the fire (sand is recommended).





9. REMOTE CONTROL

Remplace the remote control's battery

When the battery in the remote is close to being fully discharged the red LED indicator will flicker once per second indicating that you need to replace the button battery.

- 1. Please purchase a replacement button battery with model No. CR2032.
- 2. Unscrew the round cap at the bottom of the remote, see the pictures for reference.
- 3. Remove the old battery.
- 4. Insert the new battery into the slot where the old battery was, with the flat surface up.
- 5. Screw on the round cap at the bottom of the remote.

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Remote controller



Connect the remote control to the camera

- Press any key of the remote, the camera and the remote will begin the pairing process automatically, the LED indicator will blink blue before being successfully paired. After pairing, the Reporter action camera will show: "Bluetooth Pair Succeed" and the LED indicator of the remote will light blue.

Remote control utilization

Photo Shooting: Press the Photo button once to shoot a single picture, the LED indicator of the remote flickers twice.

Video Recording: Press the Video button once to start recording, the LED indicator will flicker twice, press the video button again to stop recording. Powering Off: Press the Power Off button and hold it for 3 seconds to turn off the camera, the LED indicator turns off accordingly..

10.CAMERA CONFIGURATION

· Charging the battery

- -Before using the Reporter for the first time, please fully charge the battery
 - 1. Connect the Reporter with a charger or device by Micro USB cable.
 - Charging Indicator A turns red during charging.
- 3. A complete flat battery takes around 2.0 hours to get fully charged. The red indicator turns off after the battery fully charged.
 - 4. When the battery is going to run flat, the red indicator A blinks twice a second.
 - 5. Some functions such as Wi-Fi is unavailable if the battery in low condition.
 - Note: The camera may heat up after being used for a while.

· Waterproof camera

- The Reporter can be use under water with it waterproof case. Please close it carefully to avoid any damage on the camera. Clean the case before each use, make sure there are no sand, dust, hair or other elements. You can now use your camera up to 30 meters under water.

Inserting the memory card

- This camera is not equipped with an intern SD card. For a normal operation, prepare a TF or SD card (class 6 at least), then follow the instructions below for correctly insering a SD card into the camera.
 - 1. Turn off the camera
- 2. Open the cover on the side of the camera then find the right slot. You will heard a "click" if the card has been inserted successfully.

	We suggest using Class 6 (or higher) Micro SD card for Smooth shooting. Lower Class Micro SD Cards may cause the video to blur or not record at all. There is only one correct direction to insert the SD Card into the slot. Do not force the card into the card slot as it may damage both the SD Card and camera. A new Micro SD Card should be formatted before using. The Reporter can be mounted using the accessories provided.
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11.CAMERA OPERATION

· Turn On/ Off the camera

- 1. Long press the Power button (A) for 3 seconds to power is on, indicator C turns blue.
- 2. Long press the Power button (A) for 3 seconds to power off, indicator C blinks and then turn off.

· General configuration

CONTROL	This allows user to set the microphone volume, Speaker volume, LCD Brightness.
BEEP	Turns the sound when a button is pressed on or off.
LED INDICATOR	Turns the LCD indicator on or off.
BLUETOOTH	Turns Bluetooth on or off.
QUICK RECORDING	The camera will start recording (depending on your choice: video or photo) after a few seconds when the camera is turned on.

SCREENSAVER	This will determine if the LCD will turn off after 1 min, 3 min or 5 min. Press any key to turn the screen on. Select OFF to keep the screen always ON.
AUTO POWER OFF	The camera turns off when not in use after specified time
TV OUT	Setting the desired TV standard, PAL or NTSC.
TIME SETUP	Adjust the date &time.
LANGUAGE	Change the device language, total of 4 different languages.
MEMORY FORMAT	Format the inserted SD card. Choosing to format the card will permanently erase all data on the card.
DEFAULT	Resets the camera to factory settings.
Wi-Fi	Turn the Wi-Fi function on or off.
Wi-Fi INFOS	Display the current WiFi SSID & Password.

Note: You can easily access some settings such as Beep, Mic, Speaker, Invert and Wi-Fi with touch operation by swiping up.

- Press the power/ navigation button, to start the recording.
- The duration of the recording will be show on the LCD screen.
 - -If a low speed SD card is being use, the video will be adjust in 720p automatically.

ZOOM	To zoom the image x1, x2, x3, x4.
FILTER	To define the amount of color saturation
AE METER	To define which image areas are used to calculate the correct exposure.
WHITE BALANCE	Factory default is Auto. If you switch Auto OFF, remember to adjust when lighting conditions change.
ISO	This is the measurement of the sensor's sensitivity to light.
UPSIDE DOWN	To rotate the screen.

Changing the modes of the camera

- Mode changing (A)
- When the camera is turn On, press on the button (A) to go in the differents modes: Video, Photo, Playback, Settings. Stop pressing the button (A) to select the desired mode.
- -It is also possible to access thoses modes via the touchscreen by swiping on the left.
 - 2. Mode changing (B)
- When the camera is turn On, long press on the button (B) to enter in the settings: Video Photo Effect General
 - Record videos
- Press the Shutter button (B) when powered on, LED D turns green and keep blinking twice a second; Press again to stop, and LED D light will turn off.
 - Video settings
- Press the Power Button (A) once to navigate, press the Shutter Button (B) to Enter/Confirm selection

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· Take photos

Press the Shutter button (B) once to shoot a single picture, LED D flashes green.

Photo settings

Press Power Button (A) once to navigate, press Shutter Button (B) to $\mbox{\it Enter/Confirm}$ selection.

MODE	To set the photo mode, Manual, Timelapse, Burst, Self Timer.
MEGA PIXEL	14M / 12M / 8M / 5M
FOV	To set the lens wide angle, Super Wide, Wide, Medium, Narrow.
PHOTO QUALITY	To set the picture quality.
SCENE MODE	To set different scene mode, Manual, Outdoor, Indoor, Portrait, Landscape, Night.

- You can easily access this mode with touch operation by swiping right.

Plavback

- Press the Power button (A) to navigate.
- Long press the Shutter button (B) to enter the selection.
- Short press Shutter button (B) to play.
- Short press Shutter button (B) again to exit the play control panel.

You can operate the Reporter Action camera more easily by tapping the screen.

Using the external microphone (Optional)

- Insert the external MIC to Mini USB port, the camera will automatically switch to record the sound from the external MIC. This will help to reduce noise and get better video sound.

· Transferring camera's files on a PC

- There are 2 ways to transfer the files from the camera to a PC:
 - 1. You can remove the Micro SD card from the camera and use a card reader (not included)
 - 2. You can use the included USB cable to connect the camera to your computer.

· Connecting the camera to a HD TV

- You can display the camera LCD screen on a TV screen.

Note: You will need an extra Mini HDMI to HDMI cable, which is not included in the standard package.

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- Turn the camera on.
 Connect your mini HDMI to HDM
- 2. Connect your mini HDMI to HDMI cable with the Reporter action camera and your TV.
- Select the right source on the TV.

How to use the App on a smartphone

- The Reporter allows full camera control, live previewing and playback of photos/videos on most Smart phones and Tablets.
 - 1. Download the App "Reporter App" from the "Google Play" or from the Apple "App Store".
- Activate Wi-Fi in the GENERAL SETUP MENU.


Note: You can easily access the Wi-Fi setting with touch operation by swiping up

- 3. Go to the Wi-Fi settings on your Phone, you will see Reporter_xxxxxxxx in the list of available Wireless networks.
 Note: You can change the Wi-Fi name in the menu setting.
- Connect your Phone to the "Reporter_xxxxxxxxx" via Wi-Fi.The default Wi-Fi Password for the Reporter is: 1234567890.



Important: Before connecting the camera via Wi-Fi, you need to download the "Reporter App" on your smart phone or tablet.



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12.MAINTENANCE

- The battery should be stored in a dry and ventilated area. The storage temperature range is between 18°C and 25°. Avoid to charge and uncharged excessively to extend its life. Ensure to charge it before storing it, if it won't be use for a long period.
- If the action cam won't be use for a long period, be sure to remove the batteries from the compartment. Battery leakage may damage the action cam and may cause a fire. Once used, ensure to throw the batteries according the legal regulations in order to preserve the environment.
- To avoid any problems, we strongly advise you to have the habit to remove the action cam's battery when you are not using it.
- Make sure to store your materials in a dry place, away from water and the heat.
- The maintenance can only be carried out by the After-sell Service from the shop or from the distributor. If you find a
 problem with your action cam, be sure to call them directly. It's not recommended to change by yourself the lens for
 example, because its requires technical knowledge.
- Use only the accessories specified by the manufacturer.

13.WARRANTY

This product is warranted for a period of 24 months from the date of original purchase by the consumer, except for certain wear parts, against manufacturing defects, upon presentation of proof of purchase (receipt with date, place of purchase, name of the product).

During the contractual warranty period, the defective product must be returned in its original packaging to the retailer's service center or to the www.pnj.fr website, depending on the place of purchase. After inspection of the product, the after-sales service will repair or replace the defective part or product, to the exclusion of any other compensation, if the product has been used correctly.




